The preeminent feast of Advent, is the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary, which we celebrate on Monday. Why do we let this solemnity of Our Lady temporarily overshadow our Advent preparations for the coming of Our Lord?

There is a sort of thematic connection between the Immaculate Conception and Christmas: on a natural level, the conception of the one makes possible the birth of the other. Indeed, his birth explains her Immaculate Conception - not so much the fact that she was conceived as that, at the very same moment, she was preserved from original sin.

Precisely, because she did not bear with her the marks of original sin, Our Lady was able to consent perfectly to God's will, and to prepare herself for his coming. In the season of Advent, when we ae all focused on Christ's coming in our own lives, perhaps the Church has given us the Immaculate Conception to inspire is to as virtuous as obedient, as faithful as she, in the face of this newborn Child upon whom depends so much.
