Scripture Insights

On this Second Sunday of Easter, the Liturgy of the Word begins with a most beautiful and idealistic text from Acts. Of special signifigance is the description that the Jerusalem community "was of one heart and mind," with "everything in common." How many of us struggle daily to live for the common good!

Appropriately, today's responsorial psalm is one of thanksgiving. With empasis placed on God's everlasting love. While this love is celebrated throughout the liturgical year, it is uniquely empahsised during the Easter season, when we remember the paschal mystery most intensely.

The reading from the First Letter of John, like our responsorial psalm, invites us to reflect on the incomprehensible love of God. God's commandments are not intended to be a burden for us; rather, they have been given to us as guides for living faithfilled lives.

While locked behind closed doors, Jesus appears to the disciples and offers them peace. Upon recognising Jesus, the disciples rejoice. Jesus extends peace to them a second time, then bestows the Holy Spirit on them. In yet another encounter behind locked doors Jesus appears again. This time, after

extending peace to the disciples, Jesus invites Thomas to touch him and to believe in him. This scene concludes with reference to other signs that Jesus performed so that we might have life in Jesus' name.

Connections to the Church Teaching and Tradition

When Jesus requests that Thomas touch the places where the nails went in his hand and the sword pierced his side, Jesus offers evidence of who he is. The Gospels record many instances where Jesus invited them "to verify his risen body... is the same body that had been tortured and crucified, for it still bears the traces of his passion" (*Catechism of the Catholic Chruch*, 645).

Without touching Jesus wounds, Thomas makes a declaration of his belief when he calls Jesus "Lord." The *Catechism of the Catholic Church* explains, "at the propmpting of the Holy Spirit, 'Lord' expresses the recognition of the divine mystery of Jesus. In the encounter with the risen Jesus, this title becomes adoration: 'My Lord and my God!'" (448).

REOPENING OF OUR LADY'S CHURCH FOR MASS

Our Lady's Church has now reopened for public worship. private prayer and funerals. You are reminded that the dispensation for not attending Sunday Mass, granted by the Bishops, is still in force, so there is no obligation to parishioners to attend a Sunday Mass. The safety of everyone is of paramount importance. Outside of public liturgies advertised, you are invited to come and spend time in private prayer before the Blessed Sacrament: Mondays: 2pm – 4pm and Thursdays: 10am to 12noon. I am grateful to those who have volunteered to act as stewards to ensure that we have a prayerful environment in the church and keep everyone safe by doing all we can to prevent the spread of the coronavirus. Please register your name and phone number for contact tracing or use the QR code with the NHS app, and follow the guidance of our stewards. We are now required to wear face coverings when inside places of worship. We do need more volunteers as stewards to cover the times the church is open for private prayer.
