This will take place after the Collect and then the Readers for the Mass will be presented with the new Lectionary to read from. The Rite of Institution of Readers highlights the need for prayerful and meditative preparation for your readings. May I request all the Readers to go through your Readings beforehand, and arrive at least five minutes before the Mass, to make sure that the Lectionary page is correctly kept. The person doing the bidding prayers, kindly go through it early. Finally, please do not rush through the readings but do it loudly and clearly. It's a proclamation of the Word of God!
