**Tap N Go Milestone:** Since the Tap N Go machine was installed at Our Lady's in May 2023, generous parishioners have donated more than **£20,000** through the machine for Parish Offertory, Easter and Christmas Offerings, second collections and donations. 77% of this amount has been gift aided which has meant that an additional £3,000 has been claimed for the parish. It only takes a few minutes to set up your offerings for gift aid, and then any further offerings will automatically be gift aided. The Tap N Go Machine itself was paid for from a generous donation from a parishioner, that too was gift aided. Thank you for supporting the work of the church and our parish community.
