Fraudster targeting SVP Conferences & Parishes: Concern related to a male individual who has been making repeated fraudulent requests for help to the SVP and Catholic parishes across the country. He has recently been located in the East Midlands. The individual is a man with a Northeast / Tyneside / Mackem or Geordie accent. He may say he is from Sunderland or County Durham. He has recently used the names: Christopher Hewson, Scott Hewson, Paul Hewson, Paul Cook, Scott Hudson, Christopher Henderson, Christopher Gordon, Christopher Gorton and is approximately aged between 50-55. The male seeks cash, or cash for short term accommodation or cash train tickets. He is said to use time-pressured and emotional stories which don't really add up and can become bad-tempered, rude and abrupt when support is not possible. He has been described as harassing and intimidating.
