Corpus Christi Procession: This Sunday, as we celebrate the solemnity of the **Body and Blood of Christ**, (Corpus Christi), we are delighted to have our **First Communion Children** joining the community. It's an opportunity to see them all and pray for them as well. As we did last year, if weather permits, we shall have the **Eucharistic Procession**, with the First Communion Children leading it. Please join the choir in repeating a chant or hymn. When we reach the church, the benediction hymn, "**Tantum Ergo**" will be sung, followed by benediction prayer and blessing. After which, we shall begin the Mass with the Entrance Hymn. **Please gather at the designated place five minutes before.**

The presentation basically is aimed at informing us about the kind of activities they do and also potentially looking for new members to the association. 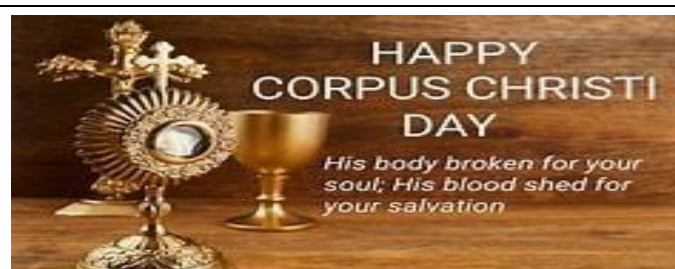
